

## Second Annual Miami Snipe Invitational 2013 Jr. Worlds Qualifier for Rio de Janiero Regatta & Clinic

January 3-6, 2013

The Snipe is a Pan American Games Class that offers sailors the opportunity to race at a high level around the world on an athletic, technical, and affordable boat.

## Clinic - Thursday, January 3<sup>th</sup> and Friday, January 4<sup>th</sup> (12:00 – 5:00)

All levels of competitors are welcome. Sailors new to the Snipe will be paired with a highly skilled Snipe crew or skipper to help them learn the nuances of the boat. The clinic will include rigging & tuning as well as boat handling and short course racing. Coaches will include US National Champions and World Champions from the Miami Fleet. New Snipe teams chartering must attend at least one day of the clinic.

## Regatta – Saturday, January 5<sup>th</sup> and Sunday January 6<sup>th</sup>

The Race Committee will attempt to run seven races. The three highest placing US teams with a both sailors under the age of 22 in 2013 will earn the right to represent the United States at the 2013 Jr. World Championships in Rio de Janiero in September. Trophies will be awarded to the Top 3 teams new to the Snipe class (sailed less than two Snipe events), Top 3 Overall, Top Junior, and Top Women's team.

Event Entry Fee: \$60

Charter Boats & Sails: \$60 includes insurance fee

Snipe Class Membership (all competitors must be members): \$15

Housing: Limited, on first come- first serve basis

Transportation: Provided from Miami Intl. Airport (Arrangements must be made in advance)
