

Complete social event program will be posted at the race office

**Scheduled races:** Five (5) races are scheduled, but not more than three races per day will be sailed. The regatta shall be valid with any number of races sailed.

**Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, the SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas, and the Deed of Gift will apply.

No national prescriptions will apply. In case of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instruction, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

Advertising: The advertizing must be in accordance with the Regulation 20 of ISAF and SCIRA Advertising Prescriptions.

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

**Entry and eligibility:** This regatta is open to all SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year subject to any Deed of Gift trophy restrictions. No skipper or crew shall be eligible to enter any Class championship race unless they possess and present a current Class Membership Card, or its SCIRA-issued equivalent.

## **Registration:**

Entry fee: € 30,-- (Payable in Croatian currency) Entry fee can be paid in cash during registration at the Race office of YC Pesja

**Measurement:** (1) all boats shall produce a valid measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee. (2) all boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

Sailing instructions: The regatta Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

**Courses:** The courses to be sailed are the Class-approved courses for a National and International Championship, as published in the current SCIRA Official Rulebook.

**Scoring:** The ISAF scoring system will be used. One race shall be discarded, if 4 races shall be sailed.

**Insurance:** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of (min. Euro 1.000.000) per event or the equivalent.

# **Disclaimer of liability**

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in the regatta is at their exclusive risk in every respect.

Awarded to: The skipper with the best total score for all the races in the 2 regattas chosen year by year by SCIRA Italy

**Open to:** Snipe skippers in good standing from anywhere in the world.

**Regatta Conditions:** Competition annually during summer on the waters of the chosen clubs. The different series of race are to be arranged and agreed upon by officials of these clubs. "Rules for Conducting National and International Regattas" are specific instructions furnished by the International Rules Committee and approved by the SCIRA Board of Governors. These instructions must be followed in all respects.

**Classification:** Each skipper receives the number of points corresponding to his place in each event. For the event in which he didn't sail, he receives the number of points of a DNC in the event with the largest number of entries. The skipper with the lowest score is the winner. In case of a tie, the skipper with the lower score in the event with more entries will prevail.

**Trophy Responsibility and Conditions:** Winner and/or his fleet to be responsible for engraving, care, safekeeping, necessary repairs, and return of trophy for subsequent competition to SCIRA Italy.

Revision of Deed of Gift: At any time by SCIRA Italy with agreement of SCIRA
