1. Rules

1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), rules for Nordic Championships and Class rules.

- 1.2 For Snipe also the SCIRA Rules for Conducting International Championship Regattas.
- 1.3 Swedish competitors shall when racing follow the licensing rules for advertising as decided by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 1.4 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 1.5 Competitor who left port must wear personal flotation devices. This rule does not apply to short-term replacement or adjustment of clothing or personal equipment, or when the competitor is in port or under deck. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation device. This changes RRS 40.
 A boat that violates this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the Protest Committee.

2. Eligibility requirements

2.1 Applies for the Swedish Championships:

To be entitled to participate in Riksidrottsförbundets championships, Swedish Championships, each competitor must comply with ISAF Regulation 19. In order to obtain the title Swedish Champion (SM) the competitors must be a Swedish citizen or has resided in Sweden for at least six months the past twelve months before the competition starts.

At championships with several crew members, a majority of the crew (more than 50%) shall meet the rule regarding the title Swedish Champion. If so, the entire crew will receive the title Swedish Champion.

Championship Signs and championship titles may only be awarded if at least six boats from at least three different clubs and two districts have crossed the finish in any race in the championship.

- 2.2 All persons on board the boat shall be a member of his/her Member National Authority or one of its affiliated organisations.
- 2.3 Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EURO 300 000 or the equivalent from time of arrival to time of departure from Motala.
- 2.4 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

3. Entries

- 3.1 Advance entry shall be made not later than 15th of June at http://www.nordicsnipe.com through the link "Registration".
- 3.2 The advance entry shall include all information required on the registration sheet.
- 3.3 The entry fee is for Snipe is 1200 SEK. The entry fee is for OK is 800 SEK.
 After 15th of June the fee will be 1400 SEK for Snipe and 900 SEK for OK.
 The fee includes After Sail, Welcome Party and Regatta Dinner for Skipper and Crew.
- 3.4 Fee is to be paid to Motala Segelsällskap not later than 15th of June.

Mark: NSW 2013, Skippers name and sail number.

Copy of receipt for registration fee must be presented at registration.

4. Registration and measurement checks

4.1 Registration shall be made at the race office not later than

Thursday 4th of July 09:00

- 4.2 Measurement certificate shall be presented prior to racing.
- 4.3 At registration shall all participants show:
 - Skippers declaration.
 - Receipt for paid registration fee.
 - Name and Sailing Club of Skipper and Crew if not done before.

10.1 RRS P will apply

11. Scoring

- 11.1 The low point scoring system of RRS A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

12. Prizes

12.1 Gold, silver and bronze plaques of the Skandinavian SF shall be awarded to the best three crews in the Nordic Championship.
Gold, silver and bronze plaques of Swedish Sailing Federation shall be awarded to the best three crews in the Swedish Championships.
In addition to this will the first 1/3 be awarded with prizes from Motala Segelsällskap.
