NOTICE OF RACE

0 PREAMBLE

The SRNA is pleased to announce the Maydays 2016 open for FJ, Laser 4.7/R/S and Snipe, to be sailed on the 30th of April and the 1st of May 2016. It will be organised by SRNA, with the participation of SailON. The event will be hosted at the marina and facilities of SRNA. The races will be sailed on the Galgenweel-lake, Antwerp.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The regulations the Royal Belgian Yachting Federation (K.B.Y.V./F.R.Y.B.), the SCIRA Official Rulebook, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. During the regatta, RRS app P will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the FJ, Laser 4.7/R/Std and Snipe classes.

3 FEES

3.1 Required fees are as follows:

FJ (BEL) € FJ (Other) €Laser 4.7/R/Std €Snipe (BEL) €Snipe (other) €

The entry fee includes: regatta and dinner (paella).

3.2 Payment of this fee will be done in cash at the Race Office.























4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration:

Saturday the 30th of April.

From 9.00h To 10.30h.

4.2 Dates of racing:

Saturday the 30th April 11.00h Start of the first race.

Sunday the 1st of May 10.00h Start of the first race of the day

4.3 Number of races:

The race committee will attempt fifteen (15) races over the two days.

There will be no Warning Signal made after 15.00h for the FJ and after 16.00h for the Laser 4.7/R/Std and Snipe on Sunday, the 1st of May, 2016

Prize giving ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the last race.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at the race office.

7 SCORING

7.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A, will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, with her worst score discarded if eight (8) or more races have been completed.

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

Overall prizes for the places one (1), two (2) and (3) of the final results.

Other prizes may be awarded.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 240 000 per incident or the equivalent.
