## WBC Snipe Regatta July 9-10, 2016 Sailing Instructions

- Regatta governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- Notice to sailors posted on WBC bulletin board.
- · Signals made ashore on committee boat the Queen.
- Race warning signal no less than 30 minutes after end of postponement made ashore.
- Check-in required for first race of each day.
- Race committee will attempt to notify boats OCS at the start; however, it is the skipper's responsibility to make a good start.
- Notify committee if not racing or retiring.
- Starting line is orange flag on committee boat and ball or buoy at port end of line.
- 5 minute flag starts with horn.
- Courses will be posted on committee boat.
- · Compass bearing to first mark will also be used.
- Windward/leeward; Triangle; Olympic courses, with port rounding, unless otherwise announced.
- Finish line is flag on whaler and ball or buoy.
- 1 race minimum; 9 race maximum.
- Course changes at leeward mark made from the Queen with horns, C flag, new mark and compass heading.
- 1 throw out if 6 or more races completed.
- Wearing life jackets is recommended; must be worn if Y flag flying.
- Boats at end of fleet may be assigned a finish.
- Race committee to be notified of intent to protest after each race, and written protest filed after last race within 30 minutes of race committee finish boat docking at WBC.
- Sailing instructions may be changed on the water by verbally notifying all sailors: L flag and 1 horn.
- No race to start after 1400 hrs on Sunday.
