1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by:
 - a. The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
 - b. The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC)
 - c. The Deed of Gift
 - d. The National Anti-Doping rule 2007
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 1.3. RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored “Did Not Finish” without a hearing.
- 1.4. RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- 1.5. RRS 30.3 will not be used.
- 1.6. RRS 32.2 and 33 will be changed to limit course changes.
- 1.7. RRS 60.1(a) will be changed to restrict protest from boats for specific items on the NoR and SI.
- 1.8. RRS 64.2 will be changed to compel the Jury/PC to abandon a race as required by RoC 18.
- 1.9. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Advertising is permitted in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20 and SCIRA rules.
- 2.2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. All competitors shall be members of Austrian Sailing Federation or any other World Sailing member national authority.
- 3.2. Regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews in good standing with SCIRA for the current year, subject to any Deed of Gift restrictions.

- 3.3. No skipper or crew shall be eligible to enter any Class championship race unless:
- they possess and present a current Class Membership Card, or
 - SCIRA-issued equivalent, or
 - shows as current member in the SCIRA Official Online Database.
- 3.4. Eligible competitors shall register within May 21st, 2017:

4. FEES

- 4.1. Entry fees: EUR 70. Late entries (after May 21, 2017): EUR 90.
4.2. Payment in cash during the registration on site
4.3. Registration should be completed on site within Saturday 3 June 2017 at 10:00

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. Registration:
2 June hrs 15:00 Registration + Warm up race (2 races)
3 June hrs 10:00 Registration ends + briefing
- 5.2. Schedule of Regatta Races:
3 June hrs 11:55 warning signal race #1, following races as in S.I.
4 June hrs 09:55 warning signal of the first race of the day
- 5.3. Prize giving ceremony as soon as possible after the last race
5.4. No more than three (3) races shall be sailed per day. Six (6) races are scheduled. Three (3) races must be completed to constitute the "South European Championship". One (1) race must be completed to constitute the "Snipe Alpen Grand Prix".

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1. All boats must have effective measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.
6.2. All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Regatta Office during registration.

8. VENUE

- 8.1. The sailing area is located in front of Segelclub Mattsee on Lake Mattsee.
8.2. Car Park: Weyerbucht Strasse.
8.3. Boat park and launching ramp: private area next to Weyerbrucht Strasse.
8.4. Clubhouse; few minute walking distance through Schlossbergweg..
8.5. Regatta office and Notice Board are located at the clubhouse.

9. COURSES

- 9.1. The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses as published in the current SCIRA Official Rulebook and SCIRA web site. More details on the Sailing Instruction

10. SCORING

- 10.1. The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.
10.2. If 5 or 6 races are completed, the worst race shall be dropped, including a disqualification.

11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance by at least Eur 1.500.000 worth. Proof of insurance shall be provided upon registration.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing or receive radio communications not available to all boats.
- 12.2. This restriction applies to mobile telephones.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 13.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. PRIZES

- 14.1. “Sergio Michel Perpetual Trophy” for the top placing team at the South European Championship.
- 14.2. Prizes for the top 3 places.
- 14.3. Special Prizes will be provided by DB Marine and North Sails.
- 14.4. Prize Giving ceremony will take place on Sunday as soon as possible after the last race.

15. MEDIA RIGHTS

- 15.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the SCIRA, organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recording, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
Photo: Organization may take pictures during the regatta or social events. They will be provided to sailors and for press purpose.
Data/privacy: All the data collected by the Mattsee Sailing club are related to the Venue management and won't be provided to any third party Authority.

Deed of Gift Sergio Michel Perpetual Trophy

Emblematic of: Top Placing team in the South European Snipe Championship

Donated by: family of Sergio Michel

Owned by: SCIRA

Awarded to: Top placing team in the South European Championship

Open to: Snipe sailors eligible to compete for SCIRA. All competing skippers and crews must be in good standing with fleet, country and the Association, and all boats must have a current SCIRA decal. Skipper and crew must be older than twelve years of age.

Regatta Conditions: "Rules for Conducting National and International Regattas" are specific instructions furnished by the International Rules committee and approved by the SCIRA Board of Governors. These instructions must be followed in all respects.

1. Six or seven races shall be sailed, depending on local conditions, of the official SCIRA courses published in the current Rulebook or SCIRA official web site (www.snipe.org).
2. If 5 or 6 races are completed, the worst race shall be dropped, including a disqualification. If 7 races are completed, the two worst races shall be dropped, including a disqualification. If 4 or fewer races are completed, all shall be counted. Three races shall constitute a regatta. In case of ties refer to current SCIRA scoring rules.
3. The Championship shall be sailed in waters selected by European National Secretaries
4. The racing rules of the ISAF shall be used.
5. The same skipper must sail all races and may be replaced after the first race only, and then only if the skipper is obviously incapacitated.

If a skipper is replaced in this manner, the first race shall be the race dropped. The same crew must sail in all races except for reasons satisfactory to the race committee.

6. The hosting organization, one year prior to the regatta, must send a letter with specific instructions covering all details of the regatta to the European General Secretary assuring them of the organization and compliance with this Deed of Gift. Some countries are not able to accommodate these rules, and the European Board may have discretion of enforcement of the rules depending on the circumstances.

Language: The official language shall be English, both written and oral. The use of other languages, as secondary, can be the prerogative of the hosting country.

Trophy Responsibility and Conditions: Winning team is responsible for engraving, safekeeping and condition of trophy, and return to the regatta the following year.

Open to: Snipe skippers in good standing from anywhere in the world.

Regatta Conditions: Competition annually during summer or late spring on the waters of the chosen clubs. The different series of race are to be arranged and agreed upon by officials of these clubs. "Rules for Conducting National and International Regattas" are specific instructions furnished by the International Rules Committee and approved by the SCIRA Board of Governors. These instructions must be followed in all respects.

Classification: Each skipper receives the number of points corresponding to his place in each event. For the event in which he didn't sail, he receives the number of points of a DNC in the event with the largest number of entries. The skipper with the lowest score is the winner. In case of a tie, the skipper with the lower score in the event with more entries will prevail.

Trophy Responsibility and Conditions: Winner and/or his fleet to be responsible for engraving, care, safekeeping, necessary repairs, and return of trophy for subsequent competition to SCIRA Italy.

Revision of Deed of Gift: At any time by SCIRA Italy with agreement of SCIRA.
