1. RULES:

1.1 The regatta will be governed by:

- a) The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) World Sailing (WS);
- b) The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC)

1.2 The Italian Sailing Federation (FIV) prescriptions will be used.

1.3 RRS Appendix P may be applied.

1.4 In case of conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

1.5 The Sailing Instructions may change other Racing Rules as provided by RRS 86.

1.6 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

1.7 The regatta is valid for the 2018 Alpe Adria Region Series

2. ADVERTISING:

2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with WS Regulation 20.

2.2 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:

3.1 The regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year.

3.2 Italian entrants shall present the FIV membership.

3.3 Foreign entrants shall present credentials approved by their National Authority.

3.4 Eligible boats may enter the regatta from April 23, 2018 to May 21, 2018 at 24.00hrs



filling and sending the ON LINE entry form to the Organizing Authority together with the payment of the entry fee.

3.5 The entry fee is €130,00 and includes racing and events. The entry fee for Junior crews is € 40.

3.6 Late entries (after May 21, 2018 but until May 25, 2018 at 11.00hrs) will be increased by €30,00.

3.7 The entry fees specified in 3.5 and 3.6 shall be paid by bank wire to BNL – Banca Nazionale del Lavoro-**IBAN: IT31 1010 0501 8010 0000 0021 100** (foreign entrants: BNL swift/bic: BNLITRR) or by payment card at the Race Office.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1 German Open – Franz Josef Cup

Registration: May 25, 2018, from 9.00 to 12.00.

Opening ceremony: May 25, 2018, at 12.00.

Skipper Meeting: May 25, 2018, at 13.00.

Races: 25, 26, 27 May 2018; the scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 13.55.

4.2 National Women and Juniore Championships–

Registration: May 26, 2018, from 9.00 to 12.00.

Skipper Meeting: May 26, 2018, at 13.00.

Races: 26, 27 May 2018; the scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 13.55.

4.3 No more than 3 races will be sailed per day.

4.4 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 17.00 hrs.

5. MEASUREMENT:

5.1 Each boat shall produce a valid Measurement Certificate and are required to properly display the current Class decal. The Measurement Certificate shall be presented at the registration at the Race Office.

5.2 Boats are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Race Committee.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration at the Race Office.

7. VENUE.

Races will be sailed in the waters of Lake Caldonazzo – Pergine/Trentino

8. COURSES:

The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses.

9. SCORING:

The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.

9.1 German Open – Franz Joseph Cup

7 races are scheduled; one race shall constitute the regatta; when fewer than 5 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores; when from 5 to 6 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score; when 7 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores



excluding her two worst scores.

9.2 National Women and Junior Championships –

5 races are scheduled; one race shall constitute the regatta; when fewer than 5 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores; when 5 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. SUPPORT BOATS:

Support boats shall register to the Organizing Committee who will assign the letter "S" as identification to be shown on the boat throughout the event.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

11.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

12. PRIZES

17th GERMAN OPEN

Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats of the final standing and to the first three German boats.

The "Middle European Cup" will be awarded to the first European boat coming from more than 1000km of distance.

The "Caldonazzo Challenge Cup" will be awarded to the first boat in the general standing.

The "Punta Indiani Trophy" will be awarded to the club that will get the lowest score considering the best three placements in the general classification first boat belonging to the Punta Indiani Caldonazzo Fleet in the general standing.

NATIONAL WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP. Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats of the final standing with female Italian crews

NATIONAL JUNIORES'S CHAMPIONSHIP National Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats of the final standing with juniors Italian crews

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, the Race Committee and the SCIRA will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE:

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.5000,00 per incident or the equivalent. The insurance certificate shall be presented at the registration and shall cover sailing events in Italy.
