Dear Prospective Sailors,

The Green Lake Yacht Club cordially invites Snipe Sailors from across the country to join us from August 23rd- 26th for the 2018 U.S. National Championships. Green Lake is a beautiful place to sail and the Snipe has a special place in our club and history. The Snipe is the primary racing fleet in Green Lake and the class spirit of inclusiveness and friendly competition has brought generations of sailors to our shores. We appreciate the opportunity to host and welcome you to our community for a fine August weekend.

Green Lake is the deepest lake in Wisconsin, with 29 miles of shoreline covering 7,000 acres. Formed in a pre-glacial valley, Green Lake sees a variety of wind conditions that challenge sailors of all ages and abilities. The town has perhaps 1,000 year-round residents, but booms upwards of 10,000 on a sunny summer Saturday. As such, there is a charming downtown with excellent restaurants, golf, nightlife, and shopping in a family-friendly atmosphere.

To provide the best possible hosting experience, the GLYC has partnered with the Green Lake Conference Center. The Conference Center sprawls over 900 acres covering miles of pristine shoreline on the northwest side of the lake. With sheltered launching areas, excellent hospitality services, and a wide range of accommodation options, this will be Regatta Central.

The last time Green Lake hosted the U.S. National Championship was in 1975, when 129 entrants made for what we believe was the largest nationals fleet in class history. Though our group is trending younger and more competitive, several participants in the '75 regatta are still active in the fleet. They have made the expectations clear: that hosting a Snipe Regatta in Green Lake is special. We intend to uphold their high standards and look forward to making history again in August.

Getting to Green Lake



Nationally


Green Lake is a rural lakeside community in central Wisconsin. The town is approximately 180 miles north of Chicago, and 250 miles southeast of Minneapolis. Getting to Green Lake is easy by air with great regional airports in Appleton, Green Bay, Madison, and Milwaukee. Given the area's lack of boat chartering options, the assumption is that most sailors will be driving. It's a smooth ride with little traffic beyond Milwaukee and readily-available services all the way in.



Locally

Snipe Nationals will be hosted in partnership with the Green Lake Conference Center, as the Yacht Club does not own property or facilities on the lake. The address for the conference center is W2511 State Rd. 23, Green Lake, WI 54941. The conference center is accessed from

Highway 23 via large brick gates. There are two such gates, and the westernmost gate offers the most direct path to the regatta site. This gate is also marked as the entrance to the Lawsonia Golf Course.



At the Conference Center

At the conference center, descend south on Lawson Drive towards the lake, past the golf course and Langford's Pub. Eventually, you will run parallel to the shoreline. You will pass the. Stambaugh house on your right, then the green-roofed boathouse on your left. Finally, you will see the "No Hurry" boat on your left in its permanent on-shore location. At this point, you should begin looking for regatta signage. There will be a parking area, boat staging area, and GLYC registration tent.

Regatta Notes and Information

- Both skipper and crew must be members of SCIRA. Registration can be processed with the skipper's information only, however this information must be confirmed before sailing
- Boats will be beach launched from the Green Lake Conference Center. Regatta volunteers from the GLYC will provide assistance and ATVs/UTVs may be used to expedite launching. Please come prepared for beach launching.
