ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS)
- 1.2 The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) available at http://www.snipe.org/images/2018Rules/SCIRA_2018_Rules-of-Conduct-final.pdf
- 1.3 The Deed of Gift, available at http://www.snipe.org/class/deeds-of-gift.
- 1.4 The RRS as modified by the Rules for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) as specified in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.5 No national prescriptions will apply (OR) The following National Prescription will apply: <Insert prescriptions>
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING:

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with WS Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1 This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year, subject to any Deed of Gift restrictions.
- 3.2 No skipper or crew shall be eligible to enter any Class championship race unless:
 - they possess and present a current Class Membership Card, or
 - SCIRA-issued equivalent, or
 - shows as current member in the SCIRA Official Online Database.
- 3.3 All entrants shall be approved by the National Secretary affiliated with the skipper.

4. FEES:

4.1 The entry fee for the championship is 60€, and can be paid by Bank transfer through:

5.2 3 races constitute the series.

If 5 races are completed, the worst race shall be dropped, including a disqualification. If 7 races are completed, the 2 worst races shall be dropped, including a disqualification. If 4 or fewer races are completed, all shall be counted.

- 5.3 There are scheduled 7 races for the South European Championship.
- 5.4 On the last racing day no warning signal will be displayed after 15h30.

6. MEASUREMENT:


- 6.1 All boats shall be presented for inspection with the full equipment, including sails and personal flotation devices during the scheduled measurement. Boats and equipment shall be presented in a dry, clean and salt-free condition. The Race Committee may extend the measurement time.
- 6.2 Measurement will take place at the club.
- 6.3 All boats shall produce a valid measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.
- 6.4 All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions will be available at 09h00 on June 07th

The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses as published in the SCIRA Rulebook or web site.

10. SCORING:

The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.

11. SUPPORT BOATS:

Support boats shall register, within the limits specified in 5.1 above, to the Organizing Committee that will assign an identification to be shown visible on the boat throughout the event.

12. INSURANCE:

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 500 000,00€ per incident or the equivalent.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION:

- 13.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.
- 13.2 This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
