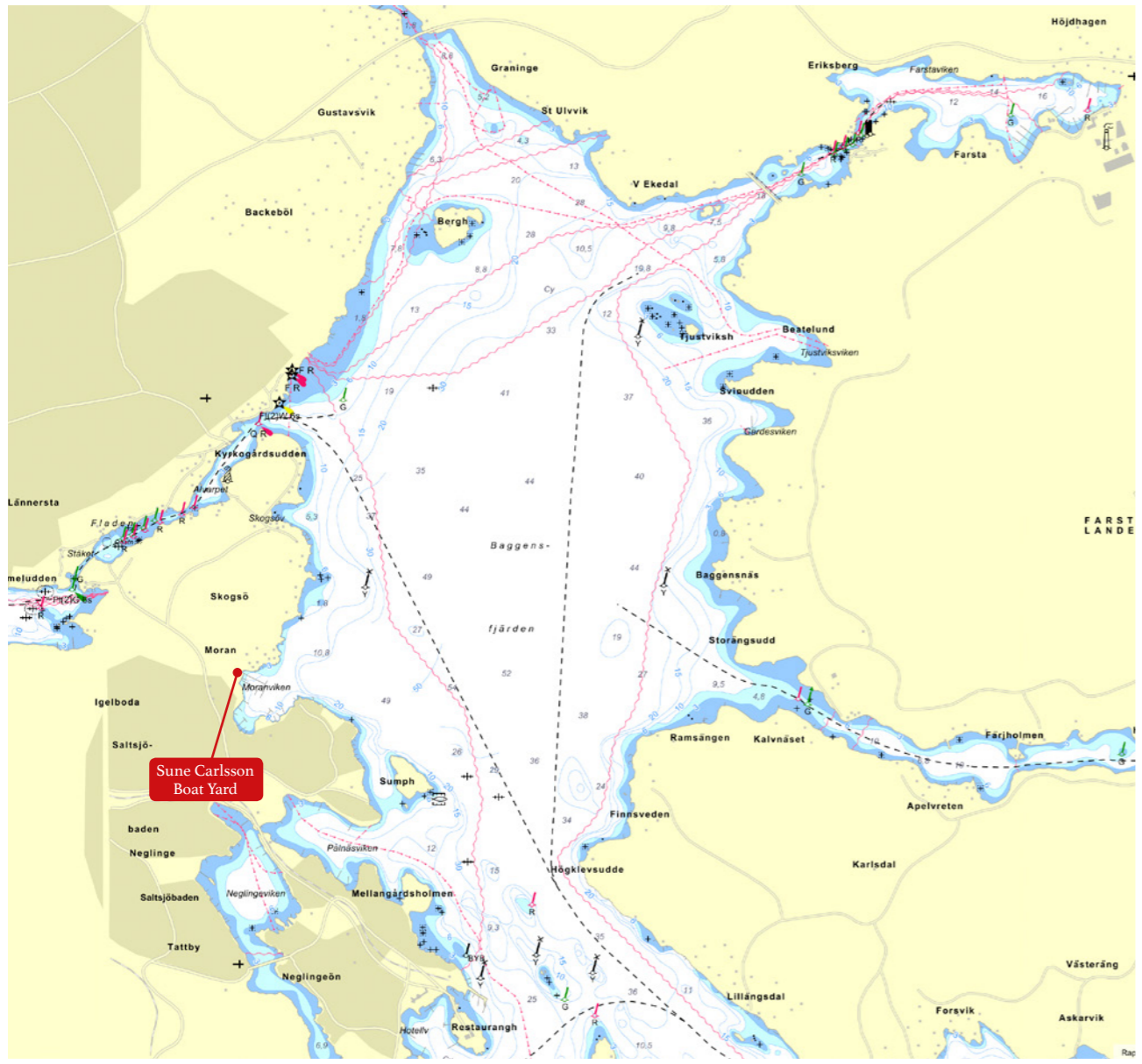

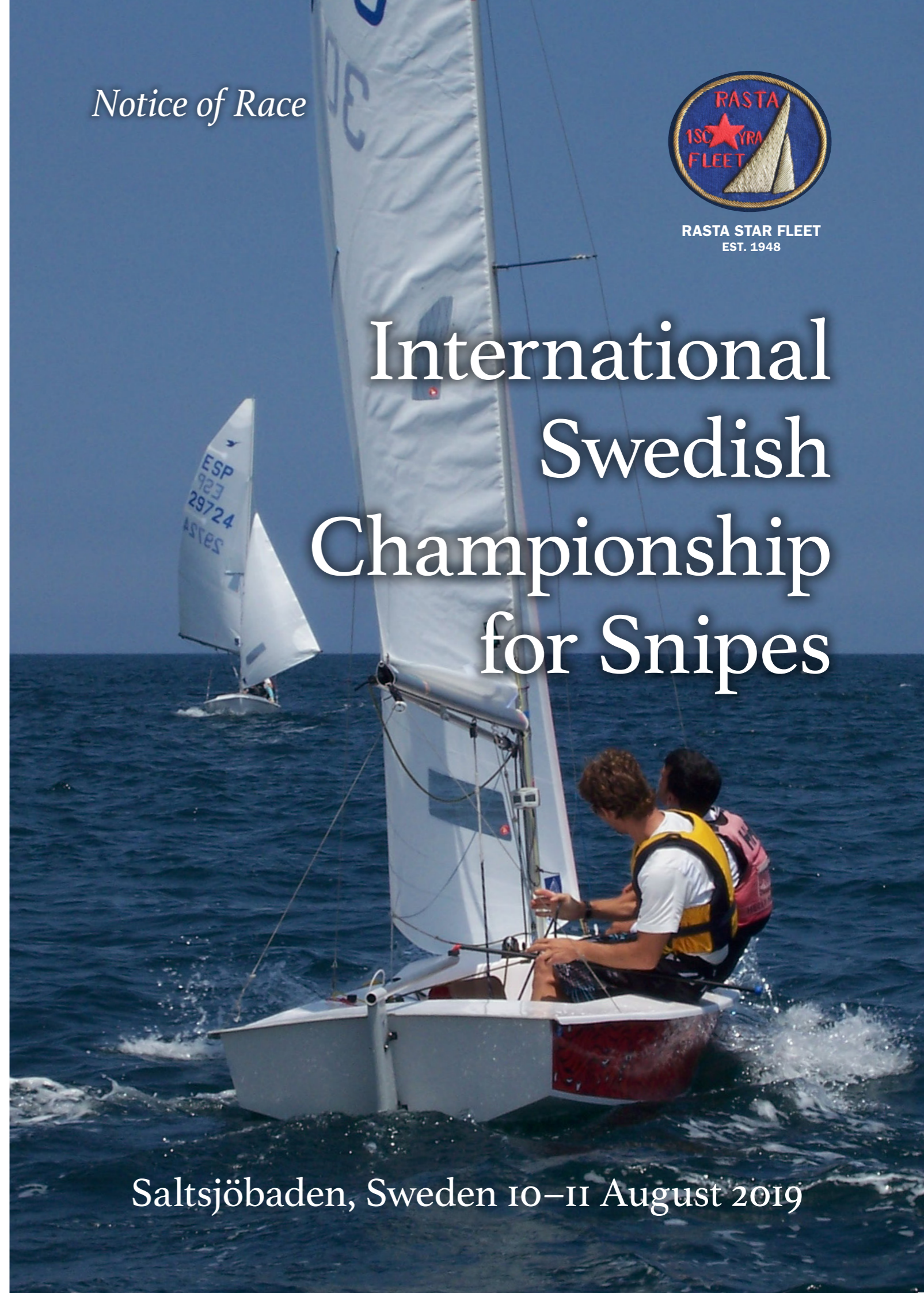

INTERNATIONAL SWEDISH CHAMPIONSHIP FOR SNIPES.
SALTSJÖBADEN, SWEDEN 10-11 AUGUST 2019

ORGANIZER: RASTA STAR FLEET

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) will be incorporated into the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3 The prescriptions of the national authority shall not apply.
- 1.4 RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6 RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish".
- 1.7 RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of racing.
- 1.8 RRS A4.1 will be changed to provide that a boat failing to check in prior to the warning signal, will be scored the same as a boat not starting in that race without a hearing. The check in must be done before the first race on each racing day.
- 1.9 RRS 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.10 Competitors shall when afloat wear personal flotation devices.
- 1.11 In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions and Supplementary Instructions shall take precedence. This changes rule 63.7.
- 1.12 All entries, when accepted, will be displayed on the organizer website. This display can be considered as a confirmation included publishing of photos taken during the event by organizers photographers.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with WS Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year.
- 3.2 To be entitled to participate in Riksidrottsförbundets championships, each competitor must comply with ISAF Regulation 19. In order to be entitled the title Swedish Champion (SM) the competitors shall be Swedish citizens or have resided in Sweden for at least six months the last twelve months before the event starts. At championships with more than one competitor per boat, a majority of the crew (more than 50%) shall comply with the rule regarding the title Swedish Champion. If so the entire crew will be awarded the title Swedish Champion.
- 3.3 Each competitor must be a member of an approved yacht club affiliated with World Sailing/National authority.
- 3.4 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 3.5 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance. The insurance policy should be presented at registration.
- 3.6 Entries shall be submitted to Rasta Star Fleet by using the entry form at www.swestar.org not later than July 19. The entry form must be completed in full.

4. FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is SEK 1800 and includes boat, car and trailer parking, if required, and regatta dinner.
- 4.2 The entry fee shall be paid to Rasta Star Fleet, BG 5319-0765, IBAN: SE816000000000342144758, SWIFT/BIC: HANDSESS not later than July 19. Entry fee after July 19 is SEK 2100.

6. REGISTRATION AND MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 Registration shall be made at the race office no later than 09.00 hrs July 10.
- 6.2 All boats shall produce a valid measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.
- 6.3 All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

8. VENUE

- 8.1 Launching and regatta office will be at Sune Carlsson Boatyard in Saltsjöbaden/Baggensfjärden.
- 8.2 Races will be sailed on Lake Baggensfjärden.

9. COURSES

- 9.1 Windward-leeward course will be sailed.

10. SCORING

- 10.1 The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. PRIZES

- 12.1 One prize per five participating boats.
