# THE CONCEPT

The idea behind the **SNIPEWINTERSERIES** is to offer Scira members the opportunity to sail and train at the RNCV Sailing Base, and compete in the Spanish Snipe Circuit, taking advantage of:



- ★ the unique Valencia weather during winter time, with high percentage of sailing days
- ★ the Club and sailing base facilities
- ★ the great spirit and way of life of our Snipe fleet

With the support of the RCNV Board, we aim at being a major South European Snipe center for all sailors across the continent. Our will to host and organize the 2019 European and Spanish Masters Championship was part of this goal, and we want to keep that momentum.

# THE RCNV

The Real Club Náutico de Valencia was founded in 1903. Its main goal is to promote nautical sports, specially in the sailing area, from its dinghy sailing school to the yearly organization of the Trofeo S. M. La Reina for ORC and Open cruise class, from hosting national to international championships in many dinghy and cruisers classes. As a result of this commitment, **World Sailing** recently choose our club and its unique sailing area during one week to test and select the new classes that will compete in the **2024 Paris Olympic Games**.

# VALENCIA

Third largest city of Spain, gorgeous Valencia is the capital of the Valencia Autonomous Region and is renowned both for its historical & cultural legacy and for its modernity, e.g. with its architectural landmarks from Santiago Calatrava. Sportingly, our city hosted major world events such as the 32<sup>nd</sup> America's Cup in 2007, a Formula 1 Grand Prix from 2008 to 2012, and is currently on the map for its top 6 world ranked marathon and the MotoGP.



## Connexions to Valencia

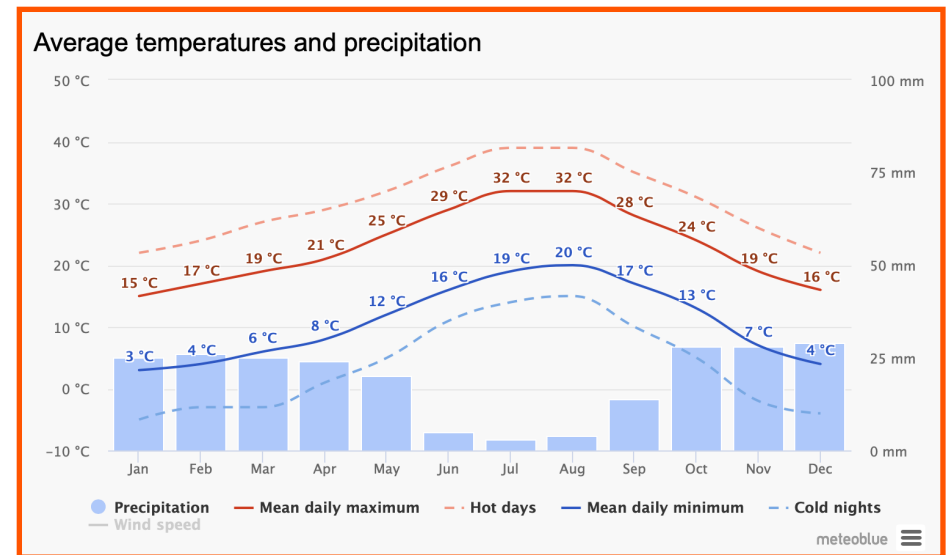
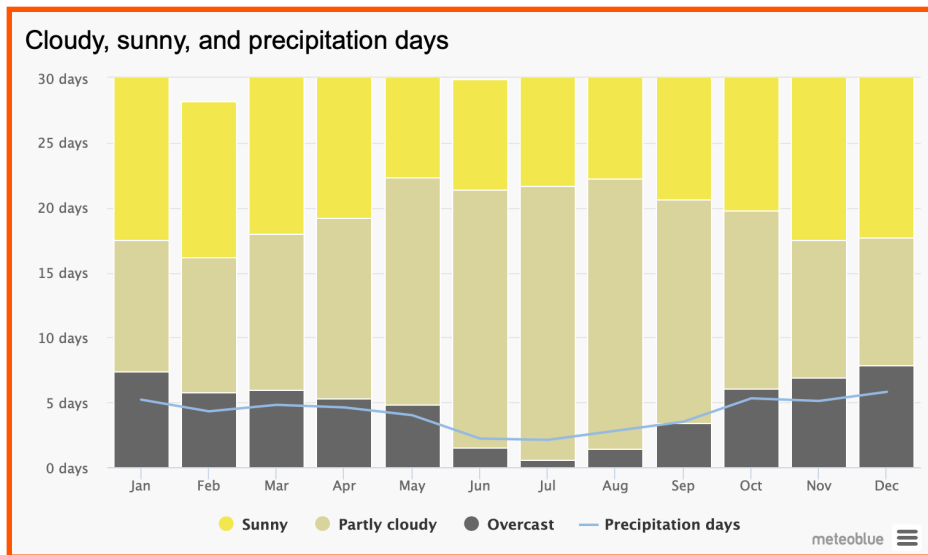

- Train station, with hourly high-speed service from Madrid in 1h40mn.

# WEATHER AND WIND CONDITIONS

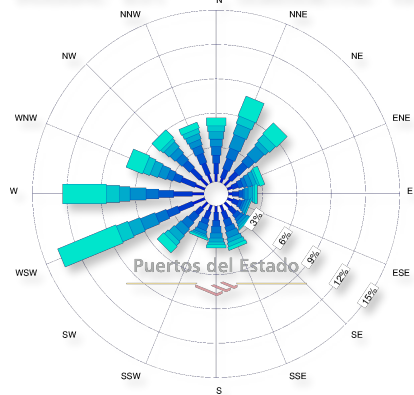
With an average 300 sunny days/year, Valencia offers great climate. Average temperature from October to April is 13,6°C, with a February lowest of 11,1°C. Winter months are fairly dry, with an average of less than 25 mm rain per month. Valencia is praised for its year long sailing wind conditions, including during winter time.



Source: Meteoblue. Averages of last 30 years. Sunny < 20% clouds < Partly cloudy < 80% clouds < Overcast

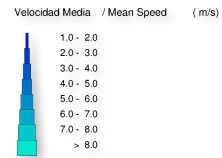
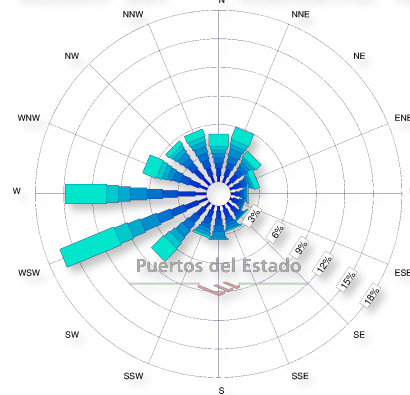

# SNIPE FLEET 154

After decades of slowly fading out, the RCNV Snipe fleet is reviving at strong pace and currently has 20+ boats on the base, with new members coming every month. Its momentum also attracts people from other regions or countries who come on weekends or holidays and sail at the base taking advantage of all its facilities and the possibility to train and race with a large number of boats and sailors; this is precisely the origin of the **SNIPEWINTERSERIES** concept.



The RCNV Snipe fleet has its own trainer, Javier Serrano, 4 times Olympic and Paralympic coach for the Spanish sailing team, and is the home of top ranked and champion Snipe sailors such as Agustín Zabalúa or Jose Luis Maldonado, our fleet Captain.

- ▶ Once a month, over the weekend, 2-days ranking regattas.

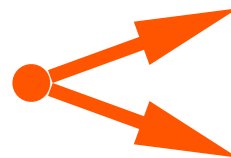
*Every training and ranking regatta is monitored by one or more RIBs, specially for coaching and safety purposes.*
