Pre-Notice of Race

Where

The 2020 edition of the Snipe Italian Championship will be hosted in Anzio Bay!

Anzio is a gorgeous town on the Tyrrhenian Sea shore, 60Km SW of Rome.

The beautiful shore-line with wide sandy beaches and deep waters, has been appreciated from thousands of years, indeed this is the birth place of Roman Emperor Gaio Augusto Germanico (aka Caligola) and Lucio Domizio Enobardo (aka Nerone).

Today is a great place for summer-vacation, with a lot of solutions for families and sea-lovers, great gastronomy and a lot of night-life.

For Racers

Anzio has been the place of the "International Sailing Week of Rome" for several decades, as part of the Eurolymp, beside many other high-ranked international Olimpic Class regattas, for the appreciation of all the teams from all over the World.

Snipe Class got historical presence here, with many important regattas as the Snipe European Championship in 2002, several Editions of the Italian Championship besides a huge number of Nationals and Winter Regattas.

During summer time there's a steady NW sea-breeze, usually around 12-15kt, with flat/choppy warm water an shining Sun. In case (not frequent) of Low Pressure there're funny conditions with pressure from SE

shifting to NW and significant long waves, quite uncommon in Mediterranean Sea.

The boats will be hosted in the yards of the Clubs, with three dedicated slipways to hit the water. All the participants will get out from inside the harbor (medium size commercial&touristic), so there'll be max safe-level for everyone.

For not Racers

Beside the beautiful beaches (fully fitted with all the beach-life needed stuff), the archeological sites (as the Nerone's Villa close to the Light-House) and the outstanding gastronomy, Anzio has a train connection (60') to/from the Rome Central-Station (Rome-Termini), so everyone "not racing" can take the chance to visit (and shopping in) the Eternal City, leaving in the morning and coming back in time for Sunset-drink! Good to know: the Clubs are really close to the Town-Center (5' of easy walk), so "not-racers" won't be lost in some not-connected, nothing-to-do, no-man-land kind of, as sometimes unfortunately happens!

Accomodations&Logistic

Anzio offers a huge amount of solutions in term of Hotel, B&B, summer-house, Camping, etc.

The International Airport of Rome – Leonardo Da Vinci – (FCO) is just 70km away, International Airport of Ciampino (CIA) is about 40km.

For all the sailors preferring to bring their own boat, the International Harbor of Civitavecchia, with connection from Spain, France and Northern Italy (Genoa) is just 120km away.

For sailors from Adriatic Europe the International Harbor of Ancona is far 350km.

Skipper and crew must be SCIRA member in good standing with their fleet, country and the Association, and sailing a Snipe registered to SCIRA for the current year.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of $1.500.000 \in \text{perincident}$ or the equivalent

ENTRY

Eligible competitors submit their Bank Transfer receipt to lni.anzio@tiscali.it, both until 12pm of July 2nd, 2020.
