1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS)
- 1.2 The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) available at http://www.snipe.org/images/2018Rules/SCIRA 2018 Rules-of-Conduct-final.pdf
- 1.3 The Deed of Gift, available at http://www.snipe.org/class/deeds-of-gift.
- 1.4 The Appendix 1 of this NoR
- 1.5 The RRS as modified by the Rules for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas (RoC) as specified in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.6 No national prescriptions will apply. In case of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instruction, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.
- 1.7 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING:

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with WS Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1 Entries should be only online via https://forms.gle/vqJkD5JyWFKS6s9M9 not later than June 24th 2021. Organiser may accept late entries with double Entry Fee.
- 3.2 **COVID PLF form** personally confirm Organizers not later than June 26th, 2021. at 10:30 hours. Filled entry form for all support person is mandatory.
- 3.3 This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year, subject to any Deed of Gift restrictions.
- 3.4 No skipper or crew shall be eligible to enter any Class championship race unless:
 - they possess and present a current Class Membership Card, or
 - SCIRA-issued equivalent, or
 - shows as current member in the SCIRA Official Online Database.

4. FEES:

- 4.1 Entry fee: 280,00 HRK (Payable in Croatian currency)
- 4.2 Entry fee can be paid in cash at the Race office of YC Orion.

6. MEASUREMENT:

- 6.1 All boats shall produce a valid measurement certificate and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.
- 6.2 All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.
- 6.3 Boats shall be presented for inspection with the full equipment, including sails and personal flotation devices. Boats and equipment shall be presented in a dry, clean and salt-free condition.

7. OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 7.1 Official notice board will be ONLY in electronical format on www.racingrulesofsailing.org. Omission to follow notices on notice board is sole competitor's responsibility
- 7.2 The Sailing Instructions will be available Official Notice Board

8. VENUE.

Races will be sailed in front of Mošćenička Draga, Croatia

9. COURSES:

The courses to be sailed are the Class Courses as published on SCIRA web site.

10. SCORING:

The low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.

11. SUPPORT BOATS:

Support boats shall register, to the Organizing Committee that will assign an identification to be shown visible on the boat throughout the event.

12. INSURANCE:

- 12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance per incident or the equivalent.
- 12.2 RC may asked competitors to wear Personal Floating Device (PFD)

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION:

- 13.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.
- 13.2 This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
