

# Notice of Race (NoR)

## Swedish Championship SNIPE



**Dates:** 2022-06-18 -2022-06-19

**Location:** Särö

**Boatclass:** Snipe

**Organizing authority:** Särö Båtklubb, SBK

### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 will apply at all times while the boat is afloat and on the water. However, it does not apply on a keelboat when it is moored or when the competitor is below deck. A boat breaking this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 1.3 When the water temperature is below +14°C a competitor shall wear clothes that prevents from hypothermia, i.e. wetsuit or drysuit.

### 2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All boats competing shall have a third party liability insurance.
- 2.2 The event is [ange "open class", and the person in charge shall be a member of a club that is a member of the Swedish Sailing Federation or her national authority.
- 2.3 The person in charge who is a Swedish citizen shall have a competition license (Tävlingslicens) issued by the Swedish Sailing Federation.
- 2.4 A competitor shall be at least twelve years old the same year this event takes place.

### 3. Entry

- 3.1 Boats may enter the event by registering online at Sailarena [www.sailarena.com](http://www.sailarena.com) or to Pelle Edwall [pelle@blomstermala.se](mailto:pelle@blomstermala.se). If you register for Pelle, payment will be made on arrival. Not later than 13/6 2022
- 3.2 The entry fee is 1500 SEK and is paid in Sailarena or to Pelle Edwall.

### 4. Registration and equipment inspection

- 4.1 Registration of the whole crew should be made in Sailarena or to Pelle Edwall not later than 2022-06-13.
- 4.2 The person in charge shall upon request be able to verify club membership, competition license and valid measurement certificate or similar.
- 4.3 A boat, crew or equipment may be inspected at any time. On the water the race committee or the technical committee may direct a boat to a specified site for inspection.
- 4.4 A competitor that has become ill or injured may be replaced after approval by the race committee.

## **5. Sailing instructions and information**

- 5.1 Sailing instructions and other official information will be available on the official notice board at Särö BK club house.

## **6. Schedule**

10:00-20:00 Registration, measurement and security control.  
Inauguration of the Swedish Championships.

#### **Saturday 14 May**

08:00 The expedition opens. Open until 09:30  
09:30 Helmsman meeting  
11:00 Warning signal today's first sailing (4 planned)  
13:00 Lunch at sea  
14.30 Waning signal

#### **Sunday 15 may**

10:00 warning signal today's first sailing (4 planed)

**No start-up procedure starts after 15:00**

**Price ceremony as soon as possible after the protocol has been made**

- 7.1 8 races are scheduled.
- 7.2 The event will consist of a series of races with all boats in the same class in the same fleet.

## **8. Venue and course**

- 8.1 See the race plan (handed out upon reistration).

Out sailing takes about 30 min.

8.2 The course will be a winward/leeward course as described in the sailing instructions.

## **9. Protests and penalties**

9.1 RRS appendix P will apply.

## **10. Scoring**

10.1 RRS A5.3 will apply.

10.2 The race committee will make no changes to the results 24 hours after the last race as provided for in RRS 90.3e.

10.3 RRS A2.1 is changed so that with three or less races, no score will be excluded. After more than three races one score will be excluded.

10.4 Three races are required to constitute a championship.

## **11. Prizes**

11.1 1st to 3rd and all participants receive benefit prizes.
