Objective: Corrector weights – Visibility and Identification

CURRENT

- C.6.2 CORRECTOR WEIGHTS
- (a) Corrector weights shall be permanently fastened in a visible position. If located inside the tight compartment they must be visible through the inspection ports.

PROPOSAL

- C.6.2 CORRECTOR WEIGHTS
- (a) Corrector weights shall be permanently fastened in a visible position. If located inside the tight compartment they must be visible through the inspection ports. Visible position is a position that permits to see the weight of the corrector weight, if marked, or to calculate its dimensions. For hulls built after Jan 1st, 2024, corrector weights shall be multiple of 0.5Kg

Reasons:

It facilitates the verification of the corrective weights in the Measurement Certificate without weighing the vessel. Limiting the weight of the corrective weights to a multiple of 0.5 kg makes it much easier to visually inspect the boat.
