Amendment Four

C.10 SAILS

Old:

C.10.3 LIMITATIONS

- (a) No more than 2 **mainsails** and 2 **jibs** shall be used during an event except when a **sail** has been lost or damaged beyond repair. A replacement shall only be made with the approval of the Race Committee.
- (b) Crews may use the sail number of any hull which dues for the current year have been paid. If the sail number is different from the hull number, the crew shall submit a request to the Race Committee. If a crew owns more than one boat he/she may use the sail number of any of his/her boats. In case of any duplicate, the Race Committee will authorize the change at its discretion.

Amend to read:

C.10.3 LIMITATIONS

- (a) No more than 2 mainsails and 2 jibs shall be used during an event except when a sail has been lost or damaged beyond repair. A replacement shall only be made with the approval of the TC.
- (b) Crews may use the sail number of any hull which dues for the current year have been paid. If the sail number is different from the hull number, the crew shall submit a request to the TC. If a crew owns more than one boat he/she may use the sail number of any of his/her boats. In case of any duplicate, the TC will authorize the change at its discretion.

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Reasons:

Change Race Committee to TC to comply with World Sailing functional definition.

Amendment Five

C.8 HULL APPENDAGES

Old:

C.8.4 DAGGERBOARD

a) For boats built before 2001:

The daggerboard retracted position limit mark shall be:

- When positioned with the top of the mark even with the top surface of the deck at the centreline of the **boat** the lowest point of the **daggerboard** to its closest point on the **hull** shall be minimum 305mm.
- Painted in a contrasting colour on both sides.
- Minimum 25 mm high.
- Minimum 350 mm long extending from the front of the daggerboard

b) For boats built from 2001 onwards:

The daggerboard retracted position limit mark shall be:

- Perpendicular to the upper front edge of the daggerboard with the top of the limit mark measured from the bottom of the daggerboard at no less than 615mm plus the distance from the forward top of the daggerboard case to the top of the deck at the centreline of the boat.
- Painted in a contrasting colour on both sides.
- Minimum 25 mm high.
- Minimum 350 mm long extending from the front of the daggerboard

Amend to read:

C.8.4 DAGGERBOARD

3) a) For boats built before 2001:

The **daggerboard** retracted position **limit mark** shall be:

- When positioned with the top of the <u>limit mark</u> even with the top surface of the deck at the centreline of the **boat** the lowest point of the **daggerboard** to its closest point on the **hull** shall be minimum 305mm.
- Marked with paint or an approved tape in a contrasting colour on both sides. Tape
 must have been specifically approved by SCIRA on a case-by-case basis. The list
 is promulgated as a Circular Letter by the SCIRA Technical Committee Chairman.
- Minimum 25 mm high.
- · Extend the full width of the daggerboard
- b) For **boats** built from 2001 onwards:

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The **daggerboard** retracted position **limit mark** shall be:

- Perpendicular to the upper front edge of the daggerboard with the top of the limit mark measured from the bottom of the daggerboard at no less than 615mm plus the distance from the forward top of the daggerboard case to the top of the deck at the centreline of the boat.
- Marked with paint or an approved tape in a contrasting colour on both sides.
 Tape must have been specifically approved by SCIRA on a case-by-case basis. The list is promulgated as a Circular Letter by the SCIRA Technical Committee Chairman.
- Minimum 25 mm high.
- Extend the full width of the daggerboard

Reasons:

Make it easier to mark the board. Full width of marking makes it easier to see.

Amendment Six

C.10 SAILS

Old:

C.10.1 GENERAL

- Sails manufactured before 1st January 2000 shall comply with the rules in force at the time of manufacturing.
- b) Sails manufactured from 1st January 2000 shall comply with these class rules.

Amend to read:

C.10.1 GENERAL

- a) Sails manufactured before the effective date of these class rules shall comply with the class rules in force at the time of manufacture.
- b) Sails manufactured from the effective date of these class rules shall comply with these class rules.

Reasons:

Update the date of rule application to make it generic. Emphasize class rules and fix grammar.
