Summary: 15 knots wind limit for women's regattas

Objective:

Lower the wind limit for women's regattas to 15 knots

Proposal:

- Rules of Conduct
- 9.3 For Women's events the maximum wind speed allowed shall be 18 15 knots
- <u>Deed of Gift</u> Snipe Women's Worlds Roy Yamaguchi Memorial Trophy Regatta Conditions

6 (c) The maximum wind speed allowed for a start shall be 18 15 *knots. A race shall be abandoned if, after the start, the wind increases over* 18 15 *knots.*

Reasons:

We propose that the maximum wind speed for women's events to be fixed at sustained 15 knots.

A great majority of women's crews are lighter and smaller, having less muscle mass and less absolute strength.

Lowering the wind limit to 15 knots will make women's regattas more secure and guarantee better fun, increasing attendance at races.
