AWARDED TO

The trophy shall be awarded to the first European skipper and crew.

ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

Age criteria are the same as those for the Master World Championship.

OPEN TO

Any SCIRA member that meets the requirements of eligibility in the year of the championship.

REGATTA CONDITIONS

1. Held on alternate years with the World Masters Championship of SCIRA at the venue selected by the European National Secretaries.
2. Six (6) races shall be scheduled.
3. The Notice of Race shall include the following:
 - (a) The Rules of Conduct for National and International Championship Regattas will apply.
 - (b) The Deed of Gift for the European Master Championship of SCIRA will apply.
 - (c) When less than five (5) races are scored, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five (5) or more races are scored, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst eligible score.
4. There must be a separate Race Committee and Protest Committee.
5. The Organizing Authority must provide an adequate number of equally matched boats with good racing capability to loan or charter to competitors who do not bring their own boats.
6. Boats to be weighed and sails measured only.
7. Trophies presented to the top 3 places in the following divisions:
 - Apprentice Master Division (45 – 54 years)
 - Master Division (55 – 64 years)
 - Grand Master Division (65 - 74)
 - Master Legend Division (75 and over).Overall European Master Champion will be top placed European team
8. Division results according to the final overall position.

LANGUAGE

The official language shall be English. The use of other languages, as secondary, can be the prerogative of the Organizing Authority and shall not be used for Official Communications with competitors from the Committees or Organizing Authority.

TROPHY RESPONSIBILITY

Responsibility for uniform engraving, safekeeping and return of the trophy to the following regatta rests with the winning skipper.
