OPEN TO

Any women who are SCIRA members in the year of the Championship.

REGATTA CONDITIONS

1. Held in alternate years with the World Women's Championship.
2. The Championship shall be sailed in waters selected by European National Secretaries and approved by the Board of Governors.
3. The Notice of Race shall include the following:
 - (a) The Rules of Conduct for National and International Championships will apply, except that RoC 5 and 6 may not apply.
 - (b) The Deed of Gift for the Women's European Snipe Championship will apply:
 - (c) From two (2) to four (4) days of racing can be scheduled.
4. The country holding the regatta must provide an adequate number of competitive boats to the skippers who are not able to bring their own boats.
5. Considering the peculiarity of the chosen venue or the availability of charter or borrowed boats, the organizers, with the agreement of the SCIRA Board, can offer different formulas for classification and rotation of charter or borrowed boats (i.e. round robin, qualifying heats, medal race).

LANGUAGE

The official language shall be English. The use of other languages, as secondary, can be the prerogative of the Organizing Authority and shall not be used for Official Communications with competitors from the Committees or Organizing Authority.

TROPHY RESPONSIBILITY

The trophy is the responsibility of the winning skipper and the National Secretary of the winning skipper. The skipper shall see that the trophy is taken care of, guarded and returned to the place designated for the next competition, properly boxed for shipment with all duties and other charges paid by the club or the fleet. The name of the winning skipper, crew, year, fleet and country shall be engraved at the country's expense in uniform engraving.
